LEADING OFF

- The Flying Bison are on pace to record nearly 800 strikeouts as a staff in 2025 after recording a league-high 581 in 2024.
- Abilene's pitching staff has struck out 39.7 percent of the batters that it has faced in 2025.
- Jorden Espinoza (Texas Tech), Landon Fuller (Tyler JC) and Emir Encalada, Jr. (UTRGV) are all in the top four in the MAL in strikeouts and have combined for 64 strikeouts in 40.2 innings.
- Espinoza leads the MAL in ERA (0.00), WHIP (0.28) and hits allowed (1).
- The offense has gotten off to fast starts almost all year, scoring in the first inning of all but three games.
- The Bison have the league leaders in batting average (Tyler Acevedo, .435), OBP (Cooper Schneider, .581), slugging percentage (Rivers, .833), RBI (Wyatt Fielding, 23), runs (Acevedo, 21), stolen bases (Rodrigo Bravo, 8), at-bats (Fielding, 61), hits (Fielding, 25), walks (Brandon Dickinson, 14), hit by pitches (Tom Chessell, 8), doubles (Fielding, 11), triples (Acevedo/Bravo/Fielding, 2), home runs (Davis Rivers, 5) and extra-base hits (Fielding, 13).
- Fielding was named the MAL Hitter of the Week for June 2-8 after putting up a .500 batting average with 12 hits and 11 RBI during the week.
