LEADING OFF

- Playoffpalooza is scheduled for Monday night at the Buffalo Wild Wings off of I-20 with a special appearance from Bomber and player autographs.
- Entering the weekend, Texarkana's magic number for the final playoff spot is 2 over Fort Smith. The fourth seed will face Joplin at 7:05 p.m. on Tuesday in the first semifinal.
- The Flying Bison will face Sherman in the other semifinal on Wednesday, also at 7:05 p.m.
- Cermodrick Bland has gotten off to a hot start with two home runs, a double, three walks and two stolen bases in his first four games as a member of the Bison. He's scored in each of his appearances as well.
- Cooper Schneider has been an on base machine in his second year as a member of the Bison, recording a MAL-record 51 walks this year while posting a .474 OBP in 51 games.
- Wyatt Fielding, Tom Chessell, Rodrigo Bravo and Schneider are the only members of the team to appear in at least 40 games in 2025. They have combined for a .281 batting average in 2025 with 44 extra base hits.
- Emir Encalada, Jr. has set season franchise records for starts (9), wins (6), innings pitched (47.2) and strikeouts (61).
- Kyrin LeBlanc holds the AFB record for saves in a season with 3.
